SERVICES

Mechanical engineering services for renovation and expansion of a 1,400 sq. ft. building for education and stewardship activities and to provide a community gathering/meeting space.

The facility features natural ventilation through the use of operable windows and radiant heating for HVAC energy efficiency. In addition, rooftop rainwater is harvested for flushing toilets. Indoor air quality is supported by environmentally-friendly paints/coatings, adhesives, sealants, wood composites and carpeting.

The learning center represents the first City of Seattle facility to achieve a LEED Gold rating.
